
#### How much did the instructor motivate you to do your best work?









#### Compared to all instructors you have had, how would you rate this instructor?



#### What did you like least about this course and instructor?

#### Students

His constant analogies to distrubiting poor grades as he was preparing us for buisness world and outside world. He was very rigid in his grading scale and would often deduct points for the most minor reasons. I felt on edge in this class and was not motivated to learn. As i prepare for finals i now understand that there is no wiggle room with this instructor.

It was a little disorganized and learning goals were not always clear.

Professor Kastart's explanation of course material is convoluted and counterintuitive. It was difficult to understand the curriculum as Professor Kastart often expressed that real world examples should not be used to assess the theories we were learning about. I and many others had expected this class to relate relevant political theories to real world events and this was not at all the case. Overall this class and instructor fell far short of my expectations and I am disappointed.

The readings could include some less dense items, like current events analysis, to make the class more relatable and interesting.

Assignments were boring and often took a lot of time to complete

lots of work. powerpoint presentation slide were just big blocks of text. slightly confusing sometimes about assignments etc. no given examples of what the assignments were supposed to be like to receive a good grade.

How hard the grading was on exams and writing assignments

I have nothing negative to say about the instructor.

The readings were generally boring and contained a lot of unnecessary information and the lectures were repetitive.

The last two books for the class were very dry and less interesting than the rest of the course.

#### What could the instructor do to improve the course or his/her teaching effectiveness?

#### Students

Encourage Students to participate, often in class it would be silent because students would not want to participate. Students knew that often when asking questions they would be dismissed and ridiculed which led to them not asking questions.

Better explain what was expected of us with the homework assignments and give better feedback.

Professor Kastart's explanation of the course material is often unclear. There is a heavy focus on theoretical arguments without relating these theories to real life examples and this makes it difficult to view the material in a real world context.

He should spend more time breaking down research methodology to make reading less cryptic.

If he shared more opinions and ideas of conservative ideas I think more republican students would feel comfortable sharing their own ideas as well. Liberal ideology and opinions seem to rule this class

more visual aids. use the chalkboard more, it's very effective when he does use it.

Grade easier on the short answer questions on the exams

Less class discussion on topics that don't relate to the material.

So much of what is discussed in class is repeated from the previous class meeting, which makes it hard to pay attention when the exact same slides are covered twice.

Get right to the point when answering a question and if no one responds to your question or no one answers it right, provide the answer instead of waiting for us to eventually guess it right.

The course is very theoretical and at time feels like the information is just being repeated multiple times in different ways.

More real-word examples to apply to lessons.

Try to be more organized, use more concise readings, and include more real-life examples.

Sometimes the class gets off topic too easily. Instructor Kastart is very nice and wishes to accommodate discussion. However, the class discussion can get too far off track and detracts from the main point.

Have more slides with more detailed information. A lot of information gets lost because he says you dont need to take notes over the slides, but the slides have more questions than answers and it is confusing.
