I found the course fairly boring.
The lectures sometimes became quite mundane, as the professor often forgot to engage with the students.
Time seemed wasted when he just let questions float.
The professor lacked organization and I had a hard time understanding the direction of the course. He also lacked feedback on assignments and exams and I was unsure what he expected for answers. The questions were hard to understand and when classmates asked for clarification he still left us confused. The readings he expected us to read were too long and complicated and was never clear what he expected us to get from the readings.
Most of the final grade was already determined before the second half of the semester.
While I enjoyed the course in general, in class discussions and lectures could have been improved.
While I understand the political theory discussed in this course centers around European Politics, I was under that we would learn the basic structures of west european governments before necessarily jumping in to specific theory. Our instructor attempted to incorporate current events into our lectures to better explain what was happening, but these current events at many times lacked necessary context for me to be able to relate it to the theory we were discussing.

As previously stated, he had a tendency to introduce some of his opinions without explicitly stating beforehand that they were his opinions. Having taken other "(Insert region) politics" classes, it would have been nice to have received a better understanding of the culture and history of Western Europe from a west European perspective. Obviously Americans as a whole are more knowledgeable on European history than say, the Middle East or China, but we approach that history as Americans and it would have been nice to get a domestic sense of their development, particularly with a more in–depth look at rising ethnic conflicts like that in Catalonia.
At points there was a lack of organization as I mentioned above but I didn't particularly dislike anything. I know based on conversations with people around me that they felt as if he was expecting too much from us as students, but I never felt that way. Really enjoyed the class.
I guess it's not really the instructor's fault but the course material is pretty boring Wish the tests reflected the material taught more precisely
the instructor was not super good at making the content interesting or enjoyable – it was hard to stay focussed for the entire class, and a lot of what he said was irrelevant/off on a tangent

**What could the instructor do to improve the course or his/her teaching effectiveness?**

Comments
Make the lectures more clear to the point.
Be more engaging with the students; ask pointed questions to the students. Also, providing more real-world examples would help keep students more engaged as well.
There are some awkward silences in class because students don't like answering questions in this class for some reason. Calling on students or rephrasing the question might move things along quicker.
Increased discussion in class, possibly through in class assignments.
Specifically when reading Mair, I felt that the chapters covered a lot of material that, while related, provided a lot of material to try and cover within one lecture period. This left my understandings of the lectures vs my understanding of the readings slightly disjointed.
Be more clear in what you're looking for when you ask questions, both in class and on the homework. There were a lot of awkward silences in class, that once you said the answer, I realized I knew and understood the answer, just not the question because of how it was worded. If the question needs to be reworded multiple times in class, it's a bad question.
He needs to work more on encouraging classroom discussion and participation. Knowing that he will eventually fill in if students don't respond to a question, most students are content to leave questions unanswered. He also has a tendency to state his own political opinions as fact. While his opinions are valuable, given the subject and his native country, they should be explicitly stated to be his opinion, less a student develop a bias that could have otherwise been avoided.
I think that at points the fact that it was his first time teaching was obvious due to a lack of organization in class. I don't feel that it ultimately affected the end product, but perhaps a bit more organization and communication to the students about what is expected of them might be best.
Material often hard to follow, maybe facilitate discussions better, essay and test questions extremely hard
less emphasis on trying to be cool and approachable – it takes away from how much students can learn and the entire class ends up feeling a bit pointless (especially in combination with dry material at points throughout the semester)
more opportunities for discussion – when we spoke in pairs no one was particularly good at speaking their opinions/having individual thoughts that weren't simply echoes of the lecture material
I would suggest that you improve your speaking skills. You speak well, but its hard for me to understand when you talk so fast and its so choppy
Pausing to make sure students understand material
Please learn how to use canvas, and make presentations more interesting. Sidetracking is a serious problem during lectures, even students who are actively trying to pay attention lose track of what is being taught and how it's relevant.
Work on the ability to lecture. They were typically very convoluted and hard to follow.
Engage in class discussions, have consistent visual aids
Perhaps reading the room a little better when asking questions that no one knows it is best to just answer instead of wait.
